18th April 1935. Ordered by the Honorable Court that the Mandamus prayed for in said Petition be granted and issued forth with unless cause to the contrary is shown by the Defendants on or before the 10th day of May 1935, provided a copy of this Petition and Order be served upon the said Defendants on or before the 25th day of April 1935.
