SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 11.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay the Electors of President and Vice-President of the United States in and for the State of Maryland, their officers and attendants.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sum of five hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated to pay the per diem of the Electors of President and Vice-President of the United States, in and for the State of Maryland, their officers and attendants. Appropriation.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the Comptroller of the Treasury is hereby directed to issue his warrant upon the certificate of the President and Secretary of the Electoral College, which assembled in the city of Annapolis on the sixth day of December, eighteen hundred and seventy-six, for such sum as may be due the several electors aforesaid, their officers and attendants. Comptroller to issue warrant.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.
