Chapter 25.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay the Electors of President and Vice President of the United States in and for the State of Maryland, their officers and attendants.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sum of five hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated to pay the per diem and mileage of the Electors of President and Vice President of the United States in and for the State of Maryland, their officers and attendants.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the Comptroller of the Treasury is hereby directed to issue his warrant, upon the certificate of the President and Secretary of the Electoral College which assembled in the city of Annapolis on the first day of December, eighteen hundred and eighty, for such sum as may be due the several electors aforesaid, their officers and attendants.
