Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Sim Lee of Frederick County Maryland do hereby manumit & set free from all manner of service to me & my heirs negro woman Kelly at present the wife of negro Ben the property of Mr. Anne Key of the District of Columbia, together with all the said Kelly's children & her future increase - the said children to be considered also manumitted & set free. Witness my hand & seal this thirtieth day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighteen.
