Whereas my slave William H. Hall has enlisted in the service of the United States, now in consideration thereof, Sarah J. Bradley of Queen Anne's County State of Maryland do hereby in consideration of said enlistment, manumit, set free and Release the above named William H. Hall from all service due me; his freedom to commence from the date of his enlistment as aforesaid in the 1<sup>st</sup> Regiment of Colored Troops in the service of the United States.

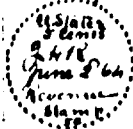

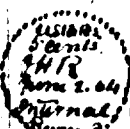
