to the Governor immediately. They left the impression in the minds of persons with whom they conferred while here after leaving the juil that their finding in the case would not tend to influence the Governor to commute Henson's sentence.

It is stated here by officials that the documents in the case so far presented to the Governor by the physicians show that Henson is considered sane and responsible for his actions.
