1857 April 17th Party arraigned Non cal & ipse
1857 April 18th Jury sworn Trial, verdict Guilty
1857 April 25th Judgment of the Court that William Campher free negro be confined in the Penitentiary of the State of Maryland until the 1st day of May 1857.

Just for knowingly having in his possession a certain abolition pamphlet, called Uncle Tom's Cabin, of an inflammatory character and calculated to excite dissention among the Colored population of this State on the 4th day of April 1857. Indictment filed - *Non Bill*

1857 April 17th Party arraigned Non cal & ipse *tried by jury*
1857 April 25th motion & leave to withdraw his election to be tried by the Country Trial before the Court Guilty (19th May 1857)

1857 May 11th Judgment of the Court that Samuel Green free negro be confined in the Penitentiary of the State of Maryland until the 1st day of May 1857.

1852 *Spuleth* *ad m* from the Governor filed.
