 heirs executors administrators & assigns on negro man by the name of Charles Wingo
 and the said Charles Wingo agrees to pay Elijah Marshall his master the sum of
 twenty dollars for year the said Marshall's lifetime and no longer & then to have
 & hold of same described property or negro man called Charles Wingo above bargained
 & sold to the said Rose Wingo his heirs executors administrators & assigns forever to
 them and their only people use & benefit and I the said Elijah Marshall for my
 self my executors administrators shall and lawfully warrant & defend by these
 presents to the said Rose Wingo her heirs executors administrators and assigns the said
 described property as aforesaid me my executors administrators & assigns all & every
 other person or persons whomsoever and I do hereby certify that I the said
 Wingo do not possess any other property or negro man or any part thereof - In testimony
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal 5th day of February on this
 day of February 1842
