

*Sudden Death.*—Dr. William J. Williams, well known as a practitioner of the Thompsonian school, died suddenly yesterday morning, at his residence, corner of Baltimore and Temple streets, after a few hours' illness of apoplexy.— Dr. Williams was highly regarded, not only as a physician, but as a citizen. He was for thirty years a member of Washington Lodge, No. 1, of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows, and was also a member of the Jerusalem Encampment of the same Order. He was likewise a member of Ottawa Tribe, No. 1, of the Order of Red Men; and in all those associations held chief positions.
