Sudden Deaths,-Dr. William J. Williams. well known as a practitioner of the Thomasonian echool, died anddenly vesterday morning, at his residence, corner of Baltimore and Temple streets, after a few hours' illness of apoplexy .-Dr. Williams was highly regarded, not only as a physician, but so a citizen.
