

THE TALBOT SLAVE ABDUCTORS.—The trial in Talbot county (Md.) court, at Easton last week, of negro Ben Thomas, slave of Wm. H. Golt, of Queen Anne's, for enticing away and aiding in the escape of certain slaves belonging to Mrs. Rogers, Mrs. M. Goldsborough and Mr. T. R. Lockerman, resulted in his conviction, on four indictments, and sentence to an aggregate imprisonment in the penitentiary of 15 years and 6 months. James Ewerk, white man, against whom there was five indictments for abducting the same slaves, was tried and convicted in two cases. His trial on the remaining three will take place at the adjourned court in Queen Anne's county, on the 21st of the present month. Bailey, the captain of the vessel which conveyed them, has also had his trial, on four indictments, removed to Queen Anne's county. The Talbot court adjourned on Friday.
