

TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS REWARD.—Ran away from the subscriber's farm, on the 25th of December last, negro MIDDLETON, called by the servants Middleton Lockie. He is a dark mulatto, about 25 years old, five feet five or six inches high, well made; has a bumpy face, a scar on the back of the neck caused by a seton when a small boy, one on the calf of the leg from the cut of a broadaxe.
