 of her body I Give and bequeath my whole Estate real and personal
 unto my beloved wife and her heirs Executors administrators or assigns
 all and singular the lands Messuages and tenements by them jointly
 to be possessed and enjoy by them their heirs and assigns forever and
 I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disannull all and every other
 former testaments wills legacies and Executors by me in any way before
 this time named called and Bequeathed Ratifying and Confirming
 this and no other to be my last will and set my hand and seal
 this day and year above written

 County in the Province of Maryland being sick and weak of body
 but of sound and perfect memory thanks be to Almighty Gods for
 the same Revoking all former Wills doe Make this my last will and test-
 ament in manner and form following Viz First and Chiefly I Give

and bequeath my soul to Almighty God that gave it me hoping through the
 meritorious death and passion of Jesus Christ my Saviour and Redeemer to
 receive free pardon of all my sins and my body to the earth to be buried
 at the discretion of my executors hereafter nominated as for what it best
 please God to bestow me with I Give and Bequeath in manner and form
 following— Item I Give unto my three Sons Samuel John and Hugh mine
 hundred acres of lands being part of a tract of lands called partnership that
 is unto my son Samuel the first part with the plantation whereon I now
 live beginning at the bounded site of said tract and running East and by
 north one hundred thirty and three perches three South three hundred
 and sixty perches west and by south one hundred thirty and three perches
 so to the first tree and good Wells to begin where Samuel has his first
 line and running East and by north one hundred thirty and three perches
 thence South three hundred & fifty perches then West and by south to my
 son Samuel land of Hugh Wells to have the remainder of said tract that
 his to the Eastern end of my son John Item I Give and bequeath unto my
 son William Wallis five hundred acres of lands lying in Queens Arms County
 called Brothers fortune and also seventy acres of land lying in Kent
 County being part of partnership that runs down to Shuter River and
 it is my will that neither of my said Sons Samuel or Hugh should
 die without issue that is his part go to my son William Wallis and if
 my son ~~John~~ should die without issue that then the share of my said son
 to have the aforesaid Equally divided between them— Item I Give
 unto my Daughter Ruth Wallis my part of apparel of lands called
 the agreement— Item I Give unto my Daughter Margaret Wallis
 my part of that land William Conroyes and my self late of cedar timber lot
 old and in case either of said Daughters should die without issue the
 survivor to have her part and it is my will that my personal Estate be
 Equally divided amongst all my aforesaid Children or the survivor of
 them Lastly I Ordain and appoint my dear and loving wife Ann
 Wallis to be my Executrix of this my last will and testament In Witness
 my hands and seal this nineteenth Day of September Anno Domini
