

\$150 REWARD.

I will give \$50 if taken in Montgomery county; \$100 if taken in the District of Columbia, Virginia, or any of the other counties of this State; and \$150 if taken in any other State, and secured in jail so that I get him again.

Also, his wife disappeared at the same time, belonging to the heirs of Samuel Crown, a slave for life, who calls herself *CAROLINE*, about five feet high, copper color. Both those servants were born and raised in this immediate neighborhood. There is also a reward offered for Caroline, the wife of Harry.
