

Maryland Caroline County to wit

Know all men by these presents that we Py and Davis & Henry Colver are held and firmly bound unto George White negro in the sum of full sum of thirty Dollars (Money) of Maryland to be paid to the said George White negro or to his Certain attorney Executor administrator or assigns to whom payment well and truly to be made and done we bind ourselves and each of us our and each of our heirs Executors and Administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 12th day of June 1841 Whereas the above bound Py and Davis think himself aggrieved by a judgment rendered against him on the fourteenth Instant by John Collier one of the Justices of the Peace for the said County at the suit of George White negro for the sum of Fourteen Dollars & ninety three Cents Dots and Eighteen Half Cents Cost from which he says the said Py and Davis is about to appeal to the next County Court for Caroline County before the deage thereof.

Now the Convention of the above obligation is such that if the said Py and Davis shall not prosecute his appeal at the County Court for Caroline County next succeeding the date of this appeal bond with effect according to the directions of the act entitled an act for the speedy recovery of small debts out of Court and to repeal the acts of assembly therein mentioned and also pay and satisfy the said George Whitonga his Executor administrator or assigns in case the said debt shall be affirmed as well the Debt damage and Cost adjudged by the said John Collier as also all Cost and damage that shall be awarded by Caroline County Court when the said appeal shall be heard tried and determined then the above bond to be and remains in full force and virtue otherwise to be of Noie effect
