Caroline County to wit, Be it remembered that on the thirty first day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty, same ~~Matthew~~ Paulsbury of Caroline County and ^{brought} a Deed of Manumission with two endorsements thereon and prayed to have the same enrolled among the records of Caroline County and on the same day and aforesaid the same Deed and endorsements were enrolled as follows to wit,

To all whom it may concern be it known that I Matthew Paulsbury of Caroline County, in the State of Maryland for diverse good Causes and consideration me hereunto moving as also in further consideration of six Cents Current money to me in hand paid. Have released from slavery liberated manumitted and set free and by these presents do hereby release from slavery manumit and set free my negro Boy named Charles when he shall arrive to the age of twenty five years of age. He being now about thirteen years and seven months old. I do declare to be free manumitted and discharge from all manner of servitude or service to me my heirs Executors or administrators for ever after the expiration of the term aforesaid: in testimony I have hereunto set my hand and seal this first day of August.

Recd on the day ^{mark} of the date within mentioned the Sum of six cents Current money it being the full consideration money within mentioned - Matthew ^{his} Paulsbury ^{Seal} - Test Geo. J. I personally appeared Matthew Paulsbury party to the within instrument of writing before me the undersigned a Justice of the Peace of the State of Maryland in and for the said County and acknowledges the same to be his act and deed for the purposes within mentioned and the negro boy therein named to be manumitted and set free at the time and age therein mentioned from me or any claiming under me according to the true intent and meaning thereof and the acts of a Assembly in such case made and provided - Acknowledged before - Geo.
