Be it remembered that on this 7th day of August A.D. 1887
there was brought to be recorded among the land records for
Kent County a Deed which is in the words following,
to wit;


This Deed, made this sixth day of October in the year
Eighteen hundred and seventy seven by me Isaac Cork of Kent County in the
State of Maryland, Witnesseth that in consideration of Five dollars and to perfect
the Title of Thomas Bright I the said Isaac Cork do grant unto the said
Thomas Bright of said County and State, all my right, title interest and estate
of in and to all that Lot or part of a Tract of land lying in the second Election
District of Kent County aforesaid on the public road leading from Quaker lane
to Still Pond Crossroads adjoining the lands of John Lusby and others, and
contained within the following Courses and distances, to wit;

Beginning at a stone set on a line with the lands of said Lusby and
running from thence as follows; South forty two degrees West three per-
ches, North sixty one degrees and a quarter of a degree West twenty three
perches and seventy one hundredths of a Perch with the land sold to Pere
Hoynson by Isaac Cork then North forty one degrees East twenty seven per-
ches and sixty five hundredths of a perch with the north side of said public
road, then South nine degrees and a quarter of a degree East thirty perches
with the land of said John Lusby to the aforesaid beginning point Con-
taining and laid out for two Acres more or less, being part of the land
formerly owned by Joseph Cotton devised by him to Isaac Cotton who
obtained it in the division of Joseph Cottons real estate and which was
sold by George Vickers, Trustee for the Sale of Isaac Cottons heirs real estate
under Decree and purchased by Isaac Cork

To have and to hold the said Lot or part of a Tract of land
Containing Two Acres more or less to the said Thomas Bright his heirs
and assigns
