Know Ye that We have pardoned unto Negro Sampson late of Great
Neotank Parish in Dorchester County Labourer the Slave of John Rider
Esq. as a proper Object of Our Mercy the Suit of Our peace and whatsoever
appertaineth unto Us for that the said Negro Sampson after the tenth
Day of July in the Year of Our Lord seventeen hundred twenty and nine to
wit the sixth Day of February Anno Domini seventeen hundred thirty
and seven with force and Arms the Storehouse of a certain Richard
Gildart Esq. at the Parish of in the County of feloniously did break and
enter and 3 1/2 Yards of white Linnen of the Value of seven Shillings Current
money 1 1/2 Yard of check'd Linnen of the Value of Two Shillings Six pence
like Money and a pair of Horse fleams of the Value of One Shilling like
Money of the goods and Chattles of the same Richard Gildart Esq. in the same
Storehouse then and there being found then & there feloniously did steal
take and bear away contrary to Our peace Good Rules and Government
whereof he was convict before Our trusty and Wellbeloved Henry Hooper
and Stephen Knight Esq. Our Justices of Oyer and Terminer and Goal delivery
for Our said County of Dorchester Nevertheless We grant unto him Our full peace
and will not that he suffer any corporal Punishment thereof but that he
shall stand and be in the same plights State and Condition to all Intents and
Purposes as if the said Felony whereof he the s^d. Negro Sampson has been
convicted had never been done or committed Witness Our trusty and
