President and Commander in Chief in and over our said Province this 25. day of October in the Year of our Lord 1774. —

Know Ye that for our especial grace we have pardoned unto Negro Isaac Dobson late of Queen Anns County Labourer the Slave of a certain John Sayer (Blaker) of the same County and whatsoever appertaineth unto us for that he the said Negro Isaac Dobson on the seventeenth day of April in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy four at Queen Anns County aforesaid and within the Jurisdiction of the same County Court with force and arms and so forth the Meat House of a certain Nicholas Rooney the said Meat House then and there being an out House and also being there and there well built with Logs and Shingles and the door thereof well secured with a Lock feloniously did break and enter and one hundred and twenty pounds of Bacon of the value of Forty Shillings Sterling Money of Great Britain the proper Bacon and of the Goods and Chattels of the said Nicholas Rooney then and there in the said Meat House being



being found then and there feloniously did steal take and bear away against  
our peace good rule and Government and contrary to the form of the Act of  
Assembly in such case made and provided whereof he the said Negro Isaac  
Dobson hath been convicted before the Worshipful John Brown Esq. and  
others Justices of Queen Anns County Court aforesaid on the fourth Tues-

County aforesaid and within the Jurisdiction of the said County Court  
in our Highway there upon one Mary Godson in the peace of God and  
of us then and there being feloniously did make an Assault and her  
the said Mary Godson in bodily fear and danger of her life in  
the Highway aforesaid then and there feloniously did put and  
one paper Bill of Credit of the Province of Maryland of the Deno-  
mination of one Dollar of the value of Sixty Pounds of Tobacco  
one other paper Bill of Credit of the said Province of the Denomination
