Whereupon the board proceeded to said Election the ballot box being prepared and Messrs. Boyle and Pindle appointed tellers, who Reported that there was 9 votes cast, and that Edwin Boyle Esq. rec'd 8 votes and Richard W. Gill Esq. 1 vote.

Whereupon Edwin Boyle Esq. was declared duly elected.
