Be it Remembered that on this fifth day of December in the year  
eighteen hundred and forty-two, an Assignment was brought to be re-  
corded among the Records of Kent County, in the following words, To-  
wiz<sup>t</sup> Kent County, December the fifth, 1842. Whereas we have bought from  
J. J. Mitchell of Kent County a quantity of Trees and Timber, part of which are now on the  
farm of said Mitchell, and the other part of which are in Worston Creek, and  
said timber have not been paid for in consideration of the premises we assign  
transfer over to said J. J. Mitchell all the said trees and timber for his benefit  
and use ~
