

An Act for a perpetuall comemoration and thanksgiving on every tenth day of June for the birth of the Prince

Forasmuch as it hath pleased Almighty God of his infinite mercie & goodness to us & our posterity to bless his sacred Majestie our dread Sovraign and his Royall consort of blessed memory in the birth of a most happy full & glorious Prince that the remembrance thereof may be eternall as farre as in us lieth equall to the great benefit & happinesse we enjoy thereof by Be it therefore enacted by the right Honourable the Lord Prop. by the advice & consent of the upper & lower houses of this present great assembly & the authority of the same that every tenth day of June for the time to come (being the birth day of the said glorious Prince) be set apart & kept holy & annually celebrated by rendering hearty publique praises and thanksgiving unto Almighty God for the great & inestimable blessing aforesaid for the generation to come as is their duty may effectually w<sup>th</sup> true praye & humble devout praise & love for the present blessing & also praye for the Majestie royall and renowned offspring may as now be the subject of our hearty & humble praises to Almighty God for ever, And be it further enacted that every person & persons inhabiting within this Province shall upon the said day annually resort w<sup>th</sup> diligent & devout to some usual Church chappell or place where such publique thanksgiving & praises to Gods most divine Majestie shall be rendered & there orderly abide during the said publick thanksgiving praye & other service of God there to be used & ministered and that all persons may be put in mind of their duty thereon by being prepared to discharge the same w<sup>th</sup> becoming devout Be it also further enacted that every Minister & Curate shall give notice to the hearers publickly in the Church chappell or place of worship at Morning service the Lords day next before the tenth day of June for the due observatow of the said day and shall then publickly and distinctly read this present Act to the people.
